In order to achieve this, there are a number of policies and procedures designed to help your child/teen make the most of their time in the program, to limit homesickness, and to limit misunderstanding by maintaining clear lines of communication. Please read the points below and sign at the bottom to indicate that you understand and agree to the following policies and procedures.

- Internet access is not guaranteed during the program. If it is available the program will limit the delegates use of the internet. This is an interactive program.
- It's preferred that the delegates do not bring phones. All Family Exchange Staff has a phone if you or your child need to communicate with each other.
- Delegates should not bring laptops or other small electronics (Nintendo DS, iPods, etc) that will distract from the experience.
- If any concerns arise during the program please contact the appropriate person in a timely manner. Most issues end up being a simple breakdown of communications or a cultural misunderstanding. We have years of experience and are happy to mediate the problem. All parties will be listened to and we ask you support the programs decisions regarding the plan of action.
- If you do not agree with the program's course of action, you may remove your child/teen from the program. However, you will be responsible for any additional cost incurred by ending the program early.
